- 1. Print or electronically complete this document.
- 2. Read and initial each statement, then sign at the bottom.
- 3. Ask your parent/guardian to also read this document, then sign at the bottom.

Expectations for Academic Success

- 1. I have created a copy of the provided pacing guide and entered my course start and end dates. I have saved it and will refer to it to ensure I complete the course in a timely manner.
- 2. I have registered an Observer to support my progress through my UC Scout course(s).
- 3. If I have a question, I will email my teacher at any time using the Inbox accessible in the Global Navigation inside my virtual UC Scout classroom. I understand I can expect a response within 24 hours, 8 a.m.–5 p.m. PDT/PST, excluding weekends and holidays.
- 4. Once registration for the course has closed, missing assignments will be marked late as they pass their suggested due date. Late assignments will receive a zero in the grade book but the zero will be replaced with the grade earned once the assignment is received and graded.
- 5. I will review the assignment settings and applicable time and submission limits before I begin the assignment. Assignment, quiz, and test settings may differ.
- 6. I will complete the course in sequential order; this means that I cannot skip around (e.g., I will not be allowed to do the Unit 2 assignments without completing Unit 1 assignments).
- 7. Once my Final Exam is submitted, the course is considered *complete*. I may not go back to redo previously submitted assignments and my teacher may calculate my final grade at this point.
 - 8. I will not submit "placeholder" submissions in lieu of submitting a completed assignment (in an effort to bypass the prerequisite settings). A placeholder is any submission intended to fill a required assignment constraint without meeting the actual assignment criteria. If I am found doing this, my ability to submit future assignments may be suspended; making this practice a habit (2 or more times) may result in a zero on the Final Exam.
 - 9. I will submit only fully original work completed by myself without any aid (human or Al). If academic integrity has been breached, a zero is earned and more severe consequences may be enforced in accordance with <u>UC Scout Course Policies</u>.

10. I understand that all required assignments may be subject to Textual Similarity and Artificial Intelligence (AI) review via <u>Turnitin</u> for the detection of plagiarism. All submitted assignments may be included as source documents in the <u>Turnitin</u> reference database solely for the purpose of detecting plagiarism of such assignments. I may submit my papers in such a way that no identifying information about me is included.

Exam Proctoring

- 1. At least two exams in this course will be proctored using a remote proctoring service. I have reviewed the proctoring information provided in the Introductory Module for my course.
- 2. I will provide a recent photo ID and use a computer microphone and webcam, as required, to complete the proctored exams.
- 3. I have read the proctoring guidelines outlined in the Introductory Module and understand the conditions that constitute a breach of academic integrity during a proctored exam and the associated consequences.

Term Limits
